Shotokan Karate. Shotokan Karate is one of the most practiced styles. It was developed in Tokyo by Gichin Funakoshi in 1938. Shotokan Karate uses both the upper and lower bodies to produce punches and kicks, which are linear and forceful. Practitioners employ powerfully delivered, straight-line strikes designed to stop an attacker or opponent quickly.

Shotokan Karate: Is It Effective for Self-Defense? \u2014 Way ...

In a nutshell, Shotokan teaches practitioners self-defense through a series of kihon (basics), kata (forms) and kumite (sparring). Shotokan is known as a hard martial arts style (rather than soft) because it emphasizes strikes, long stances and sparring techniques. Higher belts also learn some grappling and jiu-jitsu style techniques.

Called age tsuki, the technique is aimed at the underside of your opponent ' s chin or nose and launched as soon as he gets within range and drops his guarding hands. Shoto was the pen name he used for calligraphy, and as he gained experience as a karate instructor, his fighting system became known as shotokan. Already a revered instructor when he moved to Japan from Okinawa in 1922, Funakoshi established himself as a worldwide authority on karate.

The kata consists of kicks, punches, sweeps, strikes, blocks, and throws. Body movement in various kata includes stepping, twisting, turning, dropping to the ground, and jumping. In Shotokan, kata is not a performance or a demonstration, but is for individual karateka to practice full techniques\u2014with every technique potentially a killing blow; while paying particular attention to form and timing (rhythm).

Kihon basics is the practice of basic techniques in Shotokan Karate. Kihon Kata, or Taikyoku Shodan, was developed by Yoshitaka Funakoshi, the son of Gichin Funakoshi, as a basic introduction to karate kata. (Yoshitaka also developed Taikyoku Nidan and Sandan.) The kata consists of successive restatements of the theme of gedan barai\u2014oi tsuki.

Techniques Kyokushin Karate requires exceptional strength, stamina, and a very high spirit to fight. Lyoto Machida is a student of Shotokan Karate. The practitioners use a linear movement to throw impressive and quick strikes employing the elbows, hands, knees, and feet.

However, kicks to the head, knee strikes, punches to the upper body, and kicks to the inner and outer leg are permitted. In some Kyokushin organizations, especially outside of a tournament environment, gloves and shin protectors are worn. Children often wear headgear to lessen the impact of any kicks to the head.
