The temporalis muscle lies deep to the temporoparietal fascia. It is a broad, radiating muscle that arises from the temporal fossa and from the deep surface of the temporal fascia. Its fibers converge inferiorly to form the tendon, which

The blood supply of the TPF flap is from the superficial temporal artery and vein. The artery is a branch of the external carotid system.

More specifically, immediately deep to the skin and the subcutaneous tissue, just beneath the hair follicles and adipose tissue exists the temporoparietal fascia (sometimes called superficial temporal fascia). This layer is contiguous with the superficial musculoaponeurotic system as it passes over the zygomatic arch into the midface inferiorly.

Temporalis myofascial flap is a widely used material in interpositional arthroplasty. It has satisfactory results and fewer complications. However, an additional anchoring technique is proposed that can lead to a better result by preventing postoperative fibrous adhesions or reankylosis from flap dislocation due to instability.

Small hair bearing skin island, deep temporal fascia, and also segmental parietal bone can be raised with this flap. The TPF and its variants can be used as free or pedicled, one or two-stage (prefabricated and pre-laminated) flaps. When larger volume reconstruction is necessary, temporalis muscle can be added.
