Papyrus 52 (P52), which contains a small fragment of John ' s gospel, (18.31-33, 37-38) is considered to be the earliest copy of New Testament text. Discovered in 1934 by C. H. Roberts, it is believed to have been copied no later than 150 AD but no earlier than 100 AD. " Nothing is unreasonable about assigning a date of 100-125 for P52.
