The first of these, the Welfare of Livestock (Deer) Regulations, applies to deer being commercially farmed on agricultural land in Great Britain; they prohibit the removal of any part of the antlers of the 309 deer while those antlers are in velvet, with two exceptions which allow a deer's antlers in velvet to be removed by a veterinary surgeon where in his opinion this is the proper treatment of the deer for a disease or injury, and which allows anyone to remove antlers in velvet in an ...
